Reading

Please write in your child's reading record book when you have shared the book at home otherwise I will not know your child has read the book at home and therefore the book will not be changed. Homework will be given out every Friday. Year One homework will reflect and consolidate the learning happening in class. Please ensure your child hands in their homework by the following Wednesday morning please.
