In Term 3, in Science, we will be learning about Animals including Humans and looking at how they grow and change. A knowledge organiser for your reference will be coming home to support your child's learning.

We will be looking at traditional stories in English and writing character descriptions, using adjectives to describe them. We will be learning about totalling coins and using money (so get counting your money in your money box) along with line symmetry in shapes and division calculations.

The main focus for Year 2 this term again, will be handwriting and learning the Year 1 and Year 2 CEW spellings, so keep trying your best to become a Handwriting Hero!
