Worries

Please don't think you are the only one with worries about your little one spending their first full-time week in school. It's a very tricky time for all our families, but we promise if your child hasn't settled within ten minutes we will be giving you a call to let you know. If you do not hear anything from us, please rest assured that everything is ok and your child is playing happily and learning within our setting. We know that some of our children still like a nap, but they will be so busy they might not remember! If they do need to sleep, we will be in touch. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask us.

Phonics: Letters and Sounds

We start our letters and sounds work this week. The initial input is based around "Jolly Phonics" and we will be engaging the children in all sorts of follow up activities to try to help them link the phoneme (sound) and letter name. We will make sure our letters of the week are displayed on our noticeboard. Don't forget that "homework," which helps your child to retain the information, will be given out on a Friday, and should be returned no later than Wednesday morning please. The more pictures you can help them find, beginning with the initial phoneme, the better.

Mathematics: Ten Town Fun & More!

We will be working on numbers from "Ten Town". Just so you are aware the first ten characters are "King One", "Tommie Two", "Thelma Three", "Freddie Four", "Fiona Five", "Seal Six", "Sir Seven", "Eric Eight", "Nina Ninebows" and "Zero Pond." The digit we are working on will be clearly displayed so you are able to share it with your child. Maybe you could see if you could spot any on your way home? The characters are used alongside the actual number with a story, song and rhyme.

Reading Books/Reading Records/PE Kit

Now your child is in school full time it is essential that they have their reading book & reading record in their bookbag every day please. Don't worry if you haven't had a chance to share it with them because books will be changed once or maybe twice some weeks depending on what we are up to! By you adding a smiley face or comment or both we will know whether it can be changed or not on the day. All PE kit must be in school all week. It will be sent home every Friday. PE kit must be returned on a Monday morning please. Our regular slots for PE are on Tuesday and Wednesday this term so please make sure your child's hair is tied back. If they wear earrings they do have to be covered for PE and we will put micropore tape over the plain, stud earrings if worn. If your child wears tights you may like them to wear socks on PE days but don't worry we will help where and when it's needed, whilst encouraging independent changing skills.

Autumn Sunshine

We are hoping for some sunshine this Autumn. Could you please provide your child with a clearly named suncream which will stay in their tray. We will put a little into your child's hand and allow them to apply it on sunny days. If you prefer, please apply before school. We are very conscious of sun safety. Every child has been provided with a sunhat and water bottle. These will both stay in school at all times. We will rinse and refresh bottles with water daily and they will be put through a dishwasher on a weekly basis.

Pickina Up Time

Please let us know if someone other than yourself is collecting your child. If we have not met the person before, please give us a password that they can tell us so we will allow them to take your child. For the children going to "Sunshine", we receive a list each lunchtime and the children are escorted to the hall to be delivered to the staff who collect them.
