Topic: Europe (choose at least one activity)			
Week 1 Should be complete by: 16/1/19	Using an atlas or the Internet, make a list of 10 European countries and their capital cities.	Using an atlas or the Internet, choose one European country and draw a map marking its major cities and any interesting features.	Use the Internet to create a fact file about any European country.
Week 2 Should be complete by: 23/1/19	Design and draw a poster persuading people to visit a European city of year choice.	Use the Internet to create a fact file about any European city.	Design and write a postcard imagining that you have visited a European city of your choice. Tell the reader what you have liked and disliked about the city.
Week 3 Should be complete by: 30/1/19	Use the Internet to research and list the 10 tallest mountains in Europe.	Using an atlas or the Internet, choose 3 European rivers. List all the countries each river passes through.	Using the Internet, research the population of the three largest cities in any European country. Add these together to find the combined population of these cities.
Week 4 Should be complete by: 6/2/19	On a map of the UK, locate and mark the location of the following rivers: Thames, Severn, Avon, Tyne, Mersey, Trent, Exe, Tweed and Wye.	On a map of the UK, locate and mark the location of the following mountains: Ben Nevis, Snowden, Scafell Pike, Carn Eige and Goatfell.	On a map of the UK locate and make the location of the following cities: London, Manchester, Birmingham, Edinburgh, Cardiff, Glasgow, Liverpool, Belfast, Bristol and Norwich.
Week 5 Should be complete by: 12/2/19	Research and display in a bar chart, the population of 5 different countries in Europe.	Create a poster, showing the impact of overpopulation on the environment.	Imagine you are living in an overpopulated city. Write and diary entry describing your home and what it feels like to be there.
Week 6 Should be complete by: 27/2/19	HALF TERM: Write a non-chronological report about the European country of your choice. You should research and make notes before you start writing your report. You might want to use the Internet or visit the library to help you with your research. Your report can be written in your Homework Book, or you might like to type it and print it out. Don't forget to include all the features of a non-chronological report: introduction and conclusion; headings and subheadings; topic sentences; technical vocabulary; pictures and captions
