We had to see what creatures we could find in the chalk water, me and Sabina found two burrowing mayfly nymphs, five or six green water shrimps and an unidentifiable micro worm thing. We learnt that 80% of chalk rivers are in the UK, England and France, and that they were very rare.

The puzzle was super but challenging. Me and Sabina did it in 30 seconds! Even one of the assistants couldn't beat us! The rules were: you had three hoops on level one and three posts. We started on the first post and had to get it to the last one. But! We couldn't put a bigger hoop on a smaller hoop. That was tricky.

The painting was super fun! I painted a Chinese dragon, my favourite at the moment, it didn't look too good because I'm used to using pens. We had to wait for them to dry (We Lily, Olly, me and Sabina and they being the paintings). Olly did a blue cat and Sabina did a watermelon.
