Questionnaire Findings 2017

98% believe school listens to concerns 97% believe they receive valuable information. Comments were regarding whether we should provide more or less homework, some low level behaviours not being picked up swiftly enough, parking outside school, suggestions regarding hot meals and further clarification about progress. Over 68% of parents responded. Governors have considered the findings and your comments will help us to further improve our school.

Pupils feedback

93% of children enjoy school 99% feel safe at school 99% think they learn a lot in lessons 89% think behaviour is always good 98% say adults in school help me to improve 99% think the leaders in school do a good job 90% know how well they are doing at school Comments were mainly regarding additional resources the children would like in school. Other suggestions were changes to uniform, more sports opportunities and more severe punishments for children who do not follow the rules. Children also said they'd like to know how well they are doing compared to their friends. Over 98% of children took part in the survey.

As a result of the annual survey Governors and staff are considering how we can share progress more with children and parents. The school behaviour policy has already been reviewed and is in place to reduce low level issues in classes / outside, Uniform changes are coming in ready for September with a track suit option for PE, something many of the children mentioned. Sadly we cannot afford a swimming pool or to level the school field but rest assured a variety of sport will continue to be developed.
