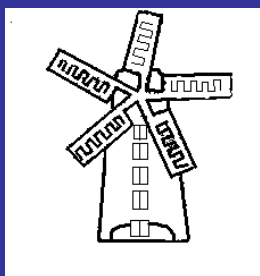


May Newsletter

Could you be saving yourself some money?

If you are entitled to free school meals you will save over £350 per year, not to mention all the time it takes to prepare packed lunches. So why not take the hassle out of preparing your child's lunches and look into whether you are entitled or not? Your claim may be successful if you are entitled to one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190.

For every child on the school roll that is entitled to Free School Meals, the school is given £1300 in addition to the School Budget. This helps us to fund additional resources and trips for the children. Don't miss out! Please help the school to access funds to which our children are entitled.
