


purchase. If you wish for any preschool children to be included then please attend from 8:45am.

Reminders...

- Please name all your child's uniform (including shoes) and regularly check that the name is still visible after washes to make it easier for your child to identify their belongings.
- Long hair should be tied back for school to help prevent the spread of head lice. It is compulsory for long hair to be tied back for P.E. lessons so please pack a hair bobble with your child's P.E. kit if they have long hair whether they are a girl or a boy.
- Earrings—only one stud in each ear may be worn and they must be covered with micropore tape or removed for P.E. lessons.
- Please inform teachers at the beginning of the day of any alterations to the normal collection of your children.
